



SDP Parent Flat Rate Pilot Program

What is the Parent Flat Rate Pilot Program?

The School District of Philadelphia has launched a pilot to provide a \$150 monthly payment (up to \$1,500 total) per household for the 2020-21 school calendar year to parents who choose to opt out of bus, van or cab assignment for their child to be transported to and from school. This will begin when your school is open for some form of in-person learning. This is not applicable when your school is 100% virtual. To participate in this program please fill out the enrollment form below.

The original deadline was August 14, 2020. This has been extended until August 28, 2020.

What do I need to do to apply for the Parent Flat Rate Pilot Program?

Inform Hebrew Public	Email info@philadelphiahebrewpublic.org to let us know you have applied for the pilot program.
Complete W-9	Complete a W-9 form and submit it to info@philadelphiahebrewpublic.org or drop it off during student material pick-up (September 1st - September 4th). The W9 form can be found here: http://bit.ly/SDPW9
Submit Parent Flat Rate Monthly Form	On a monthly basis, complete and submit the Parent Flat Rate monthly form by email to info@philadelphiahebrewpublic.org or in person to the school. Should I apply for the Flat Rate Pilot program?

My student is in Kindergarten	The School District of Philadelphia does not provide transportation for kindergarten students. Families of Kindergarten students are not eligible to apply for the Flat Rate Pilot Program.

<p>My student was not eligible for bus, van, or cab service in 19-20</p>	<p>Students must have been eligible for bus, van, or cab service in the 2019 - 2020 school year. Students were eligible if they received transportation based on an IEP, 504 plan, or lived 1.5 miles or further from Philadelphia Hebrew Public.</p>
<p>My student is eligible for bus, van, or cab service and will need that service to get to school</p>	<p>Students may only participate in the Flat Rate Pilot Program if they will not use bus, van, or cab service to get to and from school during in-person days. If students will need bus, van, or cab service, they should not apply for the Flat Rate program.</p>
<p>My student is eligible for bus, van, or cab service but I elect to drive them to and from school each day.</p>	<p>If your student is eligible for bus, van, or cab service based on an IEP, 504 plan, or distance from school, but you plan to drive them to and from school each day, you may consider applying for the Flat Rate Pilot Program.</p>
